Fraser Health is seeking dedicated and compassionate Palliative Care physicians to join our team. The ideal candidate will deliver clinical services within our multidisciplinary team and collaborate with fellow Palliative Care physicians to provide Most Responsible Provider (MRP) coverage to our Palliative Complex Care Unit (PCCU) and local hospice. Additionally, the role involves offering consultation services to patients in acute care and community-based settings.

Fraser Health has several openings for locum and permanent Palliative Care Physicians at the following locations:

- 3 x 1.0 FTE at Surrey Memorial Hospital and Surrey Community
- 0.8 FTE at Ridge Meadows Hospital and Maple Ridge Community
- 0.6 FTE at Langley Memorial Hospital and Langley Community
- 0.4 FTE at Abbotsford Regional Hospital and Cancer Centre and Abbotsford Community

Fraser Health provides integrated, regional, comprehensive palliative care services, including 30 Palliative Complex Care Unit (PCCU) beds; consult services in 12 acute care sites as well as in the community and other settings; and support to 106 hospice beds. We provide undergraduate and post-graduate teaching in affiliation with the Division of Palliative Care at the University of British Columbia.

#### Qualifications:

The successful candidate will have certification from either the College of Family Physicians of Canada or the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada. Preference will be provided to individuals who have completed additional training in Palliative Medicine, from either stream outlined below:

- One-year enhanced skills residency and acquired the Certificate of Added Competence (CAC) through the College of Family Physicians of Canada.
- Two-year Royal College subspecialty in Palliative Medicine.
