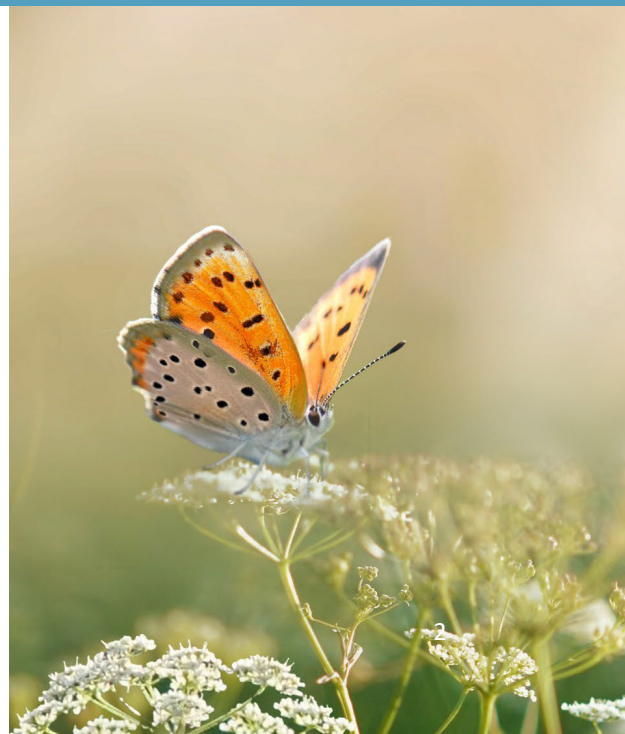

Simulation Training (New Opportunities in Development)
