

NYGH Palliative Care Physician Full-Time (1.0 FTE) Job Position

The Freeman Centre for the Advancement of Care at North York General Hospital is searching for a **full time 1.0 FTE (5 days/week and on-call responsibilities)** palliative care physician **beginning July 21, 2026** (or another mutually agreeable date).

The initial duration of this position is **6 months (to January 6, 2027)** as a Clinical Associate, with possible extension beyond based on performance evaluation, departmental needs, and mutual agreement, and potential transition to Active Staff. Compensation is fee for service.

Clinical duties include:

- inpatient consultations, follow-up and ongoing inpatient care
- on-call responsibilities (approximately 1 in 7)
- may be asked to support ambulatory clinics and/or home-based outreach responsibilities and/or long-term care consultations, as demand dictates

Skills include:

- advanced palliative care medical expertise
- compassionate, empathetic, patient centered care
- collaborative interprofessional teamwork experience and excellent communication skills
- experience and interest in education is required
- experience and interest in quality improvement and research would be an asset

Candidates must have a valid Ontario medical license and active CMPA coverage. CFPC (PC) or RCPSC certification in Palliative Medicine will be strongly considered; exceptional candidates without certification may also be considered. The successful candidate must have or be eligible to obtain a faculty appointment at the University of Toronto.

The Freeman Centre for the Advancement of Palliative Care offers comprehensive consultation and follow-up care for patients with a life-limiting illness. The inpatient team currently provides 6.0 FTE of palliative care physician inpatient support, provided by 8 physicians. Supports include an inter-professional team of nurse practitioners, palliative nurse specialists, social workers, and collaborative care with other healthcare providers, including family physicians.
